

Prohibited Activity means any activity involving terrorism financing, money laundering, or Prohibited Practices; any activity that is prohibited for financing under the applicable legislation of Ukraine; as well as any activity deemed unacceptable for financing under the Environmental and Social Management System and/or the Environmental and Social Policy of the National Development Institution and included in the Excluded Activities List.

Prohibited Practices include:

- **“Coercive Practice”** – impairing or harming, or threatening to impair or harm, directly or indirectly, any Party or the property of a Party for the purpose of improperly influencing the actions of a Party;
- **“Collusive Practice”** – an arrangement between two or more Parties designed to achieve an improper purpose, including improperly influencing the actions of another Party;
- **“Corrupt Practice”** – the offering, giving, receiving, or soliciting, directly or indirectly, of anything of value by a Party for the purpose of improperly influencing the actions of another Party;
- **“Fraudulent Practice”** – any act or omission, including a misrepresentation, that knowingly or recklessly misleads, or attempts to mislead, a Party in order to obtain a financial or other benefit or to avoid an obligation;
- **“Obstructive Practice”** – in relation to an investigation into a Coercive Practice, Collusive Practice, Corrupt Practice, or Fraudulent Practice in connection with the implementation of the Program:
 - (a) deliberately destroying, falsifying, altering, or concealing evidence material to the investigation; and/or threatening, harassing, or intimidating any Party to prevent it from disclosing information relevant to the investigation or from pursuing the investigation; or
 - (b) acts intended to materially impede the exercise of contractual rights of audit, inspection, or access to information.
